The Travel Plan Coordinator (TPC) for Lowfield Green is a point of contact for residents who require information about sustainable travel and how to access the available funding.

Sustainable Travel Fund

To help promote sustainable travel from Lowfield Green, a sustainable travel fund has been made available by the developer.

The first occupants of each house at Lowfield Green will be able to take advantage of this fund. Residents will:

- have the choice between 50 single bus tickets for use on First York buses, or a £55 voucher for use towards a cycle, cycle accessories, or servicing at selected local cycle retailers and
- be entitled to a years free Enterprise Car Club membership and £100 drive time

Walking

Many amenities are within walking distance of Lowfield Green. Walking for local trips can help many people to be physically active every day, something that is recommended by the NHS. Walking to school is a great way for children to keep active.

The map opposite shows the area that can be reached within 10- and 20-minutes of walking from Lowfield Green at a pace of 4km/hr.

Cycling

For information on free cycle training, electric bikes, leisure cycle routes, an up to date copy of the York cycle map, and other useful cycle content visit itravelyork.info/walk-cycle

iTravel is encouraging e-cycle uptake, with free 7-day trials and substantial discounts if you decide to buy. Cycles suited to your mobility requirements are included itravelyork.info/e-cycle-switch

Public Transport

Bus stops can be found on Tudor Road and Green Lane, both are a 5-10 minute walk from Lowfield Green. The sustainable travel fund offers residents 50 single bus tickets for use on First York buses. Contact the TPC for more information about how to claim.

The buses that use these stops all provide services to York, via either Acomb, Foxwood, or Holgate. The number 4 which runs from York to Acomb has 5 buses per hour at peak times, roughly one every 12 minutes.



Car Club



There will be an Enterprise Car Club car at Lowfield Green, initially located at the Restharrow Road entrance to Lowfield Green. Residents are entitled to free car club membership for one year, plus £100 of free drive time*. Contact the TPC for joining info.

Car club membership offers the benefits of having access to a car without having to own one. Being a member of the Enterprise Car Club means you can use an Enterprise Car Club car in any UK city where they operate, not just the city you signed up in, and there are vans available too.
